Explanation of Screening/Assessment

LAP-D = the Learning Accomplishment Profile-Diagnostic Standardizing Assessment; is a developmental assessment for children ages 30-70 months. This assessment helps the teacher make educational objectives, strategies and decisions regarding all children. This assessment is given at the beginning of each school year and monitored throughout the school year.

LAP-3 = the Learning Accomplishment Profile - is designed as a valuable guide for observation of typically developing children as well as young children with disabilities.

****Children with a score of "P" will be administered a LAP-3****

*****Children with a score of a "R" will be administered a LAP-D*****

This and all information regarding any child is maintained in a confidential manner. This information will be used by the classroom teacher in the planning of each child's individualized education plan. The Health and Disability Specialist and Education Specialist will access this information for the purpose of providing services and program planning. Parents will have access to information at any time.
